## Requirements for the minor in PHILOSOPHY, 2024-2025

The Philosophy minor consists of at least **24 total units**, at least 20 of which must be upper-division, with courses distributed according to the listing below. Note that if a lower-division course is chosen to fulfill a requirement in Area I, additional upper-division elective units will be required.

All courses to be applied to the minor must be completed on a letter-grade basis. This includes both courses offered in Philosophy and those offered by other departments and applied to the minor.

- No more than 5 upper-division units overlap between this minor and the upper-division portion of the
  major(s) or other minor(s). If overlap is greater with the major(s), completion of the minor will not be
  formally recognized; if overlap with other minor(s) is greater, only the first minor reported will be
  recognized.
